The Program

The Royal Canadian Legion's Track and Field Program is a program that allows athletes, ages 17 and under to compete in both indoor and outdoor situations.

The Indoor Program consists of the Provincial Meet that is held every year at York University. The Outdoor Meet, on the other hand, has a District, Provincial and a National Meet.

With the National Meet, athletes spend a just under a week with the selected team learning from experts as well as getting to compete.

How Athletes Qualify

For District Meets there is no qualification Meet. The only requirements are that the athlete lives within the District, who's event they are at.

The results obtained at the District Meet are what determine who is selected to go to the Provincial Meet. In District B the team is selected by the District chairmen, with primary confirmation made by the coaches.

For the National Meet, athletes are selected from the top contenders that were put forth from each District .



Upcoming Dates
